General rules

- You may submit a maximum of three digital images of your favourite cake you have previously created into any of these categories where relevant.
- The images must show front and sides of the cake. (Images of the back are not required).
- Images must not have any logos or watermarks attached to or on them.
- You **must not** submit any cakes **previously** entered into any competitions online or at any shows, if you do, this will mean immediate disqualification.
- Your entry **must** be your own unaided work, we respectfully ask you to follow this rule, if you do not, you will be disqualified.
- There is no size specification for any of the categories.
- Any age can enter these categories unless specified.
- Deadline for entries is Monday 20th April at 1700 hrs.

How do I enter?

- Entry is free.
- Choose your category one entry per category per person.
- Choose your favourite cake image.
- We need to see front and side of the cake maximum of 3 images.
- Email the image to **cake compentry@ichf.co.uk** along with your full name, category chosen and your country.

What are the prizes?

- Courtesy of The Cake Decorating Company, prizes are £50 voucher to each winner of floral category, wedding category, cupcakes category, cookies category and decorative exhibit category and each Junior category.
- Best in Show will win a £150 voucher and Junior Best in Show will win £100 voucher.
- Please note: there are no awards or grading for individual entries but one winner per category.
